### **Helpful Hints when filling out your Scholarships**

1. Make sure to get Scholarship in before their due date
2. Put all scholarship on a calendar/for a reminder of when they are due to the organization(s)
3. Put correct postage on Scholarship package
4. Fill out Application Completely, neatly and sign the Scholarship if necessary
5. Ask Reference(s) to complete their portion of the Scholarship information packets early
6. Have Teachers or Parents read over essays for spelling mistakes (***be prepared to write an essay on a topic of the scholarship organizations choice***)
7. If you are awarded a scholarship, make sure to send a Thank you note to the organization & send any information or senior pictures that the organization requests.
8. Search for Scholarships in your Junior and Senior year of high School, scholarships are due anywhere from October thru May of your Senior year. (**most of the State bowling Scholarships are due between Feb & March of your senior year**)
9. If you are awarded a Scholarship at an awards Banquet, make sure to Say **Thank you** and be grateful for this Scholarship and make sure to shake hands with the presenter of the organization who is giving you the Scholarship, (***remembering that the organization works very hard to fundraise for the Scholarship dollars***)

10. Make sure to get 3 to 5 reference letters from Teachers, Coach's, counselors, principals, association members, local board members, neighbors, or adult friends of the family

**(most scholarships will not except a reference from a family member or a youth friend)**

11. If you are awarded a scholarship, make sure to keep all documents given to you by the organization who awards you the Scholarship, so when it is time to redeem the Scholarship, you know who to contact to get the Scholarship dollars.

12. Make sure to read all documents when awarded a Scholarship, so you know what the deadline is to redeem the Scholarship.
